## Figure 17. Conditions for operative vaginal deliveries

- 1. Full cervical dilatation
- 2. Membranes ruptured
- 3. Engagement of the fetal head
- 4. Head is vertex or mento-anterior
- 5. Variety of position must be known
- 6. No disproportion between head size and pelvic size (mid-pelvis)
- 7. Empty bladder
- 8. Adequate analgesia
- 9. Operator familiar with labor course and the clinical assessment of pelvis and fetal size
- 10. Experienced operator (or supervisor)
- 11. Knowledge of advantages and techniques of different instruments
- 12. Operator prepared to abandon procedure
- 13. Capability of performing a C/S if difficulties encountered
